1. Violence

Genesis 6:13	Violence	Exodus 1-2
Noah	Danger	Moses

2. Ark

Genesis 6-9	Ark	Exodus 2:3,5
TEVAH – Hebrew for Ark	Both uses of the term indicate deliverance from water death	Only other place Moses uses the term

3. Covenants

Genesis 6:18, 9:11-17	Covenants	Exodus 19-24
	Entered into with Noah. Later Moses is the administrator of the Covenant	

4. Water Judgment

Genesis 6-9	Water Judgment	Exodus 13-15
	Flood destroyed the wicked as was done to the Egyptians	

5. Wind

Genesis 8:1	Wind	Exodus 14:21
	Wind was used to diminish the sea in both cases.	

6. Animals

Genesis 6:19	Animals	Exodus 1-40
	God commanded Noah to bring animals into the Ark. On no less than four occasions Exodus reports that many animals left Egypt with Israel	

7. Divine Remembrance

Genesis 8:1	Divine Remembrance	Exodus 6:5
	Noah was remembered by God in much the same way God remembered His covenant with Moses.	

8. Blessing of Nature

Genesis 8:22	Blessing of Nature	Exodus 11:12
	There would be a new stable world order for Noah and his family. Moses then repeated that in the Land of Promise Israel would know nature as controlled and stable.	

Exodus 40:34-38

“³⁴ Then the cloud covered the tent of meeting, and the glory of the Lord filled the tabernacle. ³⁵ Moses was not able to enter the tent of meeting because the cloud had settled on it, and the glory of the Lord filled the tabernacle. ³⁶ Throughout all their journeys whenever the cloud was taken up from over the tabernacle, the sons of Israel would set out; ³⁷ but if the cloud was not taken up, then they did not set out until the day when it was taken up. ³⁸ For throughout all their journeys, the cloud of the Lord was on the tabernacle by day, and there was fire in it by night, in the sight of all the house of Israel.”

“¹⁵ Then Moses went up to the mountain, and the cloud covered the mountain. ¹⁶ The glory of the Lord rested on Mount Sinai, and the cloud covered it for six days; and on the seventh day He called to Moses from the midst of the cloud. ¹⁷ And to the eyes of the sons of Israel the appearance of the glory of the Lord was like a consuming fire on the mountain top.”

“⁵ Not that we are adequate in ourselves to consider anything as coming from ourselves, but our adequacy is from God, ⁶ who also made us adequate as servants of a new covenant, not of the letter but of the Spirit; for the letter kills, but the Spirit gives life. ⁷ But if the ministry of death, in letters engraved on stones, came with glory, so that the sons of Israel could not look intently at the face of Moses because of the glory of his face, fading as it was, ⁸ how will the ministry of the Spirit fail to be even more with glory? ⁹ For if the ministry of condemnation has glory, much more does the ministry of righteousness abound in glory. ¹⁰ For indeed what had glory, in this case has no glory because of the glory that surpasses it. ¹¹ For if that which fades away was with glory, much more that which remains is in glory.”
