The Christ Title –

Revelation 3:1

“^{3b} ... He who has the seven
Spirits of God and the seven
stars, says this:”

The Commendation

There is none.

No mention of false doctrine.

No mention of Balaam situation or
Nicolaitan errors.

“Wake up,” verse 2.

“I have not found your
deeds complete,” verse 2.

“Soiled clothes,” verse 4.

The Correction

Revelation 3:2-3a

“² Wake up, and strengthen the things that remain, which were about to die; for I have not found your deeds completed in the sight of My God. ³ So remember what you have received and heard; and keep it, and repent.”

“Wake up!”

Literally means “Be watchful.”





The Consequences

Revelation 3b-5

“^{3b} ... Therefore if you do not wake up, I will come like a thief, and you will not know at what hour I will come to you. ⁴ But you have a few people in Sardis who have not soiled their garments; and they will walk with Me in white, for they are worthy. ⁵ He who overcomes will thus be clothed in white garments; and I will not erase his name from the book of life, and I will confess his name before My Father and before His angels.”

**Here, however, the “coming” is
not Christ’s end time return,
but him coming in judgment
over this church.**
