Glossary of Terms -- Buddhism

- 1. Anatta -- Concept of no self. No permanent or immortal self such as in Hinduism.
- 2. **Anicca** -- Change or impermanence found throughout human life.
- 3. Arhat -- Person dedicated to following a discipline of life that leads to Nirvana.
- 4. **Bodhi** -- Enlightenment. Already mentioned was the Bodhi tree or Bo tree.
- 5. Bodhi Sattza -- Person who reaches enlightenment but who does not pursue Nirvana.
- 6. **Dharma** -- Duty, law's teaching.
- 7. Dukkah -- Pain or suffering in basic conditions of human life.
- 8. **Karvna** -- Compassion for other people or creatures.
- 9. Natto -- Similar to the Christian's idea of the end times. These are the last days.
- 10. **Nirvana** -- Total release, the cessation of the craving life, rebirth. Not clearly defined as in Hinduism.
- 11. **Tuja** -- dedication to certain gods.
- 12. Sanadhi -- Reaching the highest form of meditation. An unconscious state or trance.
- 13. Sanana -- Concerns wandering, ascetics, hermits, strict follower of Buddha.
- 14. Sanara -- Similar to reincarnation or transmigration. Cycles of rebirth.
- 15. Sangha -- Monks who adhere strictly to Buddha's discipline of life.
- 16. **Satori** -- Enlightenment.
