“Christ is the Perfect Revelation”

65-69 AD Written by an unknown author to a group of Christians with a Jewish background. They had endured the immediate and early persecution: prison, confiscation of property, public ridicule and contempt. Yet, they have not matured as disciples – 5:11-13, so when new persecutions arose and a despondency at the lack of swiftness of Christ's return, they began to waver, abandoning hope. Threatening to renounce Christ and revert to the “security” of the Jewish faith, which was protected at that time under Roman Law.

The author calls them to renewed commitment to Christ, who is the fulfillment of every promise of the Jewish Scriptures as Messiah. He is so vastly superior to the prophets, angels, Moses, the patriarchs and the old covenant, that to go back is to leave God and his perfect revelation given, who is Jesus Christ.

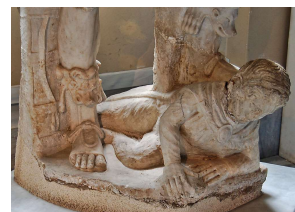
